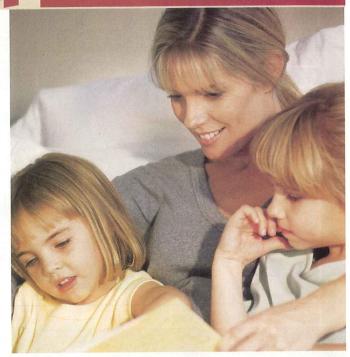
"People told us they wanted more space," Bill tells me on our way is attracting a broat to the second suite. "So we made many of the Circa homes larger than in earlier build-
