
Child Care Facility Tour Wednesday May 21, 2008. 3 PM - 5 PM



The child care centre in the Mole Hill Community Housing complex provides 25 spaces for 3-5 year olds, as well as other child development services including drop-in, playgroups, and evening and weekend parenting programs.

The Mole Hill Community Housing project includes 27 vintage homes that have been restored, rebuilt and/or converted for affordable and market housing, and a variety of health and social programs, and two family daycare units. The child care centre is located in one of these houses.

Join the children, parents and staff of Bayshore Garden's Children's Centre in a springtime planting session in honour of Child Care Month!

Located in the Bayshore Gardens residential towers in Coal Harbour, the Bayshore Gardens Children's Centreis a 49-space licensed child care facility operated by the Vancouver Society of Children's Centres. The program provides 12 infant, 12 toddler and 25 much-needed spaces for 3 to 5 year olds in Vancouver.

The centre was built and furnished by the site owner as a condition of rezoning the Bayshore Lands for residential development. This new facility includes 5,200 sq. ft. of indoor space, 5,600 sq. ft. of outdoor play space.
